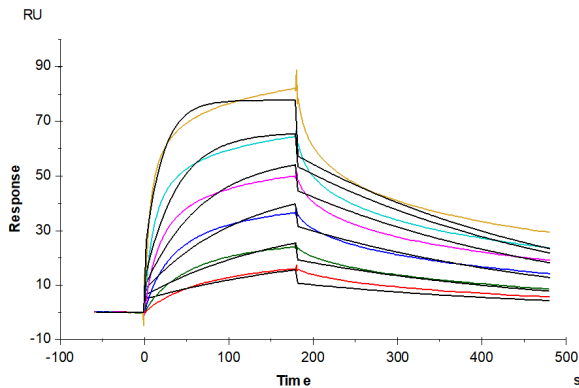
Description	
Source	Recombinant Human Claudin 18.2 Protein-Nanodisc is expressed from HEK293 with His tag at the N-terminus (FITC-equivalent protein is fused on cytoplasmic part). It contains Met1-Val261.
Accession	P56856-2
Molecular Weight	The protein has a predicted MW of 49.10 kDa.
Endotoxin	Less than 1EU per µg by the LAL method.

Formulation and Storage	
Formulation	Supplied as 0.22 µm filtered solution in PBS (pH 7.4). Notice: Not recommended for flow cytometry in mammalian cells.
Storage	Valid for 12 months from date of receipt when stored at -80°C. Recommend to aliquot the protein into smaller quantities for optimal storage. Please minimize freeze-thaw cycles.

Background	
Claudin18 (CLDN18) belongs to the large claudin family of proteins, which form tight junction strands in epithelial cells. CLDN18 is specifically expressed in the stomach and lung. CLDN18 has two alternatively spliced variants, CLDN18.1 and CLDN18.2. Isoform 2 (Claudin 18.2) is abundant in gastric tumors.
